



Jewellery

With the exception of small stud earrings, please do not send children to school wearing jewellery. Jewellery, and other loose accessories, can be a health and safety hazard in school, especially in the playground and during PE lessons.

There is also a risk that it will get broken or lost. For these reasons, children wearing earrings will be asked to remove them, before taking part in PE lessons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves, please provide them with tape or plaster for them to cover the earrings. They will be unable to join in with PE lessons unless this is done.
