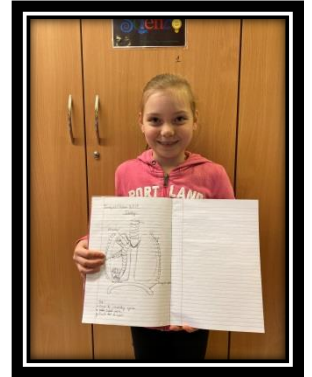


Parents evening
