



Road safety

It has come to our attention that some of our parents are not supervising their children as they cross the roads. Please can you ensure that your child is supervised as they cross for their safety when dropping off or collecting.



School uniform

A reminder to parents that children must wear closed in footwear for school. Open toes and strappy sandals are not permitted for health and safety reasons. Shoulders must be protected from the sun, so please ensure that your children dress appropriately for the weather. If the weather is very hot apply sun cream to your child before school, children are not permitted to wear sunglasses in school.

Jewellery

With the exception of small stud earrings and watches, please do not send children to school wearing jewellery. Necklaces, ankle bracelets and other loose accessories can be a health and safety hazard in school, especially in the playground and during PE lessons. There is also a risk that it will get broken or lost. For these reasons, children wearing earrings will be asked to remove them, before taking part in PE lessons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves, please provide them with tape or plaster for them to cover the earrings. They will be unable to join in with PE lessons unless this is done.

### Home work

Your child will be given homework books every Friday, with specific pages to be completed over the weekend and returned to the class teacher on Monday morning.



### Reading

Reading is a very important part of your child's development, parents are advised to find quality time to listen to their child read every day for 30 minutes.

### Face masks

As we continue to stay safe, face masks must still be worn outside the school gates when dropping off and collecting your child. If you have to come into the school a face mask must be worn. Please be mindful of social distancing when you drop off and collect your child at the school gates. Help to keep your children, yourselves and the school staff safe.


