Children need to be able describes each place in detail using the correct key vocabulary.</p> <p>Explain to children that topography is the study of the lands surface: hills, valleys, rivers, mountain, plains etc.</p> <p>Focus on the different cultures and people. What the surface of the land is used for.</p> <p>Fieldwork – visit a key aspect of topography: river, mountain, hill.</p>

Our place in the England and the UK as well as the wider world.</p> <p>Name and locate some counties and cities of the United Kingdom, geographical regions, identifying human and physical characteristics, key topographical features.</p> <p>Conduct a filed study of the local area.</p> <p>Begin to make a sketch map of a short route within a local area, annotating key features.</p> <p>Use letter/no. co-ordinates to locate features on a map.</p>
