Covid Update (NHS guidance)

Testing Free testing services have closed at pharmacies, test sites, schools, etc. You might be eligible to order a free pack of rapid lateral flow tests that will be sent to your home. Use this service to check if you are eligible:

Isolation guidance

While you are no longer legally required to self-isolate, if you've tested positive for COVID-19 or have symptoms of COVID:

- Adults should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days
- Avoid meeting people at higher risk from COVID-19 for 10 days, especially if their immune system means they are at higher risk of serious illness from COVID-19, even if they've had a COVID-19 vaccine
 - If a child or young person aged 18 or under tests positive for COVID-19, they should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days. This starts from the day after they did the test.
 - Children and young people tend to be infectious to others for less time than adults. If they are well and do not have a temperature after 3 days, there is a much lower risk that they will pass on COVID-19 to others.
